Our highly qualified nurses deal with a range of conditions and health concerns. They help run the specialist clinics, give advice on contraception, lifestyle, provide wound care, travel and 'flu vaccinations, childhood immunisations, new patient health checks, anticoagulation and blood pressure monitoring, ear syringing and offer other health related treatments and care.

Practice Manager

Reception staff

The Reception staff are here to help you. They answer the phone, deal with enquiries and repeat prescription requests.

Linkworker for the Elderly

Alex Johnson supports and visits patients over 75 years of age and offers a wide range of advice and contacts for service access.

Health Visitors, The Community Matron and District Nurses

This team is attached to the practice and employed by the Primary Care Trust working in the community to support our patients in clinics and in their own homes. The Health Visitors offer health advice and support families with younger children.

Counsellors

We are able to refer patients to the community mental health team and also have a member of the IAPT (Psychotherapy) team visiting the practice once a week. This service can be accessed through the doctor or by self referral.

Please contact the surgery to check exact appointment times as these may differ according to type of service provided. A nurse is available during all opening hours.

Practice Area

The practice area covers most of the W1 postal district. A map is available at Reception should you wish to see it.

How to Register

The NHS list is open for new patients to register if they live in the practice catchment area. You can register online, in person or by post and will be required to fill in a registration form and new patient questionnaire. Your NHS Medical card will be helpful but is not essential. Proof of home address such as a utility bill or rental agreement will also be needed together with proof of identity. Also you will be asked to book for a new patient health check to complete registration. This involves a short review of past medical history, medications and allergies as well as a blood pressure check, basic urine test, height and weight. Please bring in any current medication or information that you think might help including the Red Book for children under the age of five years.

Appointment System

You can book an appointment by phone, in person or on line. We also see patients who walk-in on the day.

Urgent cases are seen or contacted on the day by the duty doctor.

If your condition is non-urgent you can either book an appointment in the next two working days or book up to four weeks in advance. You may have to wait longer if you want to see a particular doctor although we aim to provide you with appointments with your preferred choice.

Check with the receptionists as you may find a nurse or other health care worker would be able to help you instead of a doctor. You may also find that a telephone consultation with your doctor would work better for you. Just let the receptionist know.

Where appropriate we offer e mail consultations for routine problems. More details can be found at reception.

Change Of Personal Details

Please inform us if you change any of your personal details, address or telephone number so that we can update our records.

Repeat Prescriptions

If you take medication on a longterm basis, you can ask for a repeat prescription. Please complete the tear off section of your computerised prescription and allow two working days from request to collection. Your request can be hand delivered to reception during opening hours, put through the letter box, sent by post or ordered on line. If you wish your prescription to be returned by post please attach an SAE. Ask at reception for details on how to request repeat prescriptions via the internet.

Access To Premises

Most clinics are held on the ground floor and there is a lift to the lower ground floor for other clinics. The surgery is fully disabled compliant. There are baby changing facilities.

Patient Participation Group
